All of us at Me too & Co are absolutely thrilled that JVA Brokers chose us to receive your support. Such a generous gift will help us to keep supporting some of the most disadvantaged children and their families in our area. We have recently started a new project where we bring in a mobile kitchen to our venue so that children can learn cooking skills, life skills really, along with their families, in a way that is adapted to their needs. These can include physical impairments, behavioural or emotional impairments, and dietary concerns as a result of other diagnosis (Crohn's disease for example).

Parents and children have told us this has been one of the most rewarding sessions we've offered, bringing then together in a way that isn't always possible in a home kitchen setting. We don't have any grant funding for this and the sessions cost Me too & Co £600 each, so your wonderful donation will allow us to provide almost 6 sessions! Our families will be so pleased to know there are more cooking skills opportunities on the way.

We would be really delighted if you'd like to come and visit us. I will send you through some dates after Christmas when you can come and see the sessions in action.
